THE COVER

The engraved and carved rifle shown on the cover is a Weatherby Mark V, in cal. 7 mm. Weatherby Magnum. The rifle telescope is a Weatherby Imperial 4x81. The rifle is a 'sheep gun' owned by Herb Klein of Dallas, Tex., a big-game hunter who has a double collection of all 4 species (Big horn, Desert, White [Dall], and Stone) of North American big horn sheep. He currently has 7 sheep listed in the Boone & Crockett Club's "Records of North American Big Game". He also has taken many species of foreign sheep.

The engraving is by Luther Daniels of Dallas; wood carving is by Weatherby's Inc., South Gate, Calif.

The 4"x5" transparency is by Harry C. Knode, of Dallas, Tex., using a Linhof 4x5 camera, with Ektachrome Type B film, exposed 1/2 second at F/32, using 3200° K lights.
