

# Dillon Sued in Labor Dispute

SCOTTSDALE, ARIZ. — Dillon Precision Products, Inc., noted manufacturer of ammunition reloading equipment and purveyor of the free shooting/reloading magazine/catalog known as *The Blue Press* was cited today for exposing a group of seasonal laborers, a.k.a. "elves," to the abnormal amount of lunacy and financially sound acquisition advice offered in the Christmas issue.

*The Blue Press*, as explained by a Dillon spokesperson, is a combination magazine/catalog that specializes in extraordinary values in reloading and shooting equipment while at the same time brutalizing sacred cows over and over. Sacred Cow Union Local 243 has entered the fray as a friend of the court.

According to reports, Elf Union Local 357 says its members are developing an inordinate interest in firearms-related sports and activities as a result of being continually exposed to *The Blue Press*. The original plaintiff, one K. Kringle, who was on a sabbatical in Miami and unavailable for comment, claimed his labor force was, at one point, intent on mounting Browning .30s on his delivery sleigh to help alleviate traffic delays.

At press time, the judge was sequestered in his judicial washroom examining back issues of *The Blue Press* which had been entered into evidence. Laughter emanating from that area has not been explained.
