




RECIPE

Fixed Flavor Star Ham Omelet

TOTAL TIME: 20 MINUTES

Beat the white and yolks of four Armour's Cloverbloom Eggs separately. To the yolks add two teaspoons Armour's Cloverbloom Butter, a pinch of salt, and one cup of boiled Fixed-Flavor Star Ham finely chopped. Make a smooth paste of one level tablespoon flour and one-fourth cup of milk, and gradually add one-half cup of milk and the well-beaten whites of the eggs.
