Fernand Bourges' photographs of Fra Angelico's panel episodes of the life of Christ (*pp. 52–61*) are his sec-ond Christmas assignment for LIFE in as many years. For 1945's Christmas as many years. For 1945's Christmas issue he photographed Gozzoli's Ad-oration of the Magi. A color specialist since the Lumière plates of 30 years ago, Bourges served as an aerial pho-tographer in World War I, where his early experience with filters proved invaluable for cutting through haze.
