With a nervous eye cocked at the highvoltage electric wires that surrounded him, LIFE Photographer Nat Farbman perched precariously on top of the 40-foot tower shown at left to take pictures of a house being built in only 34 minutes (see pp. 12-14). Hal B. Hayes built the tower especially for LIFE's use, attached a sign to the scaffolding which said, "... only for LIFE magazine." This forestalled other photographers who were near scene from duplicating Farbman's original idea.
