The graphic image of an ornate tower clock on this month's cover is one of London's, and the world's, best-known and most photographed landmarks—Big Ben, also known as the Parliament Tower clock at Westminster Palace. While some schoolmarm's insist that "Big Ben" actually refers to the massive bell that sounds the quarters and hours, rather than the clock itself, few will argue that photographer Bernard van Berg's exquisitely sharp, dynamically angled partial image of it goes well beyond the ordinary tourist snapshot. Van Berg shot the massive ticker on an uncharacteristically bright, sunny morning using a Leica SLR and a long tele lens.
