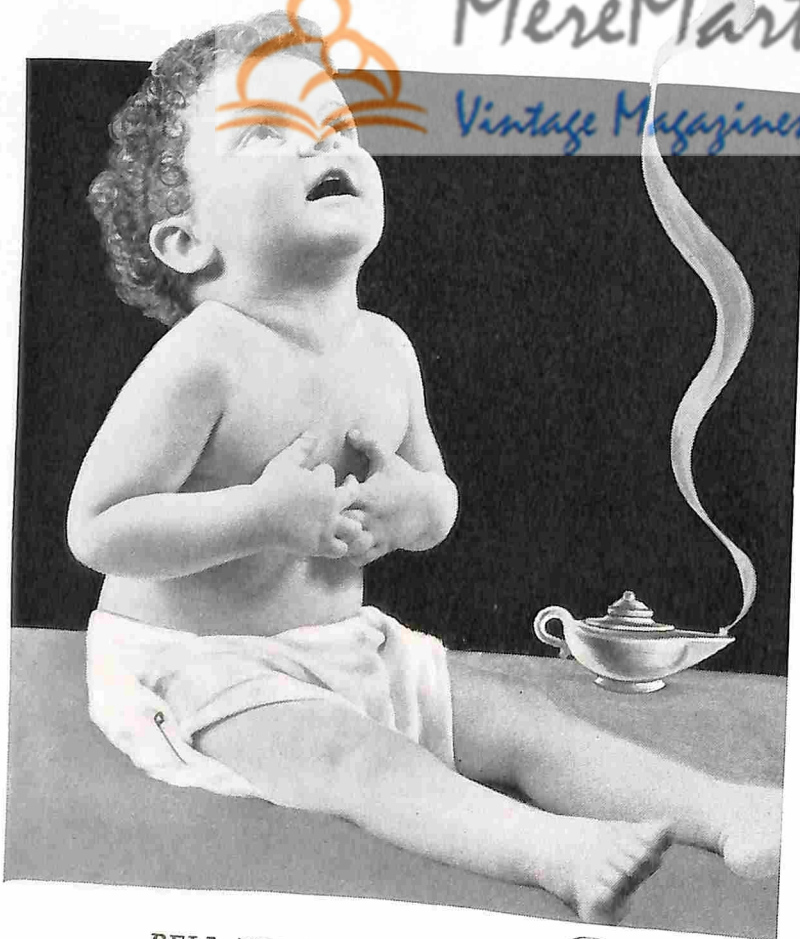
A telephone, that's what, young Aladdin Jones. And I can do so many things I'd make Aladdin's genie curl up with shame!
