## THE COVER

The transparency of this bobwhite quail was made near Santa Fe, Tenn., by J. Ennis Humphrey of Reseda, Calif. By placing bird seed on the log and whistling to imitate a female quail, Humphrey lured the bird into camera range of his blind. Camera was a Hasselblad with 300 mm. telephoto lens, using Ektachrome Professional film exposed 1/250 second at F/8 with electronic flash fill illumination.

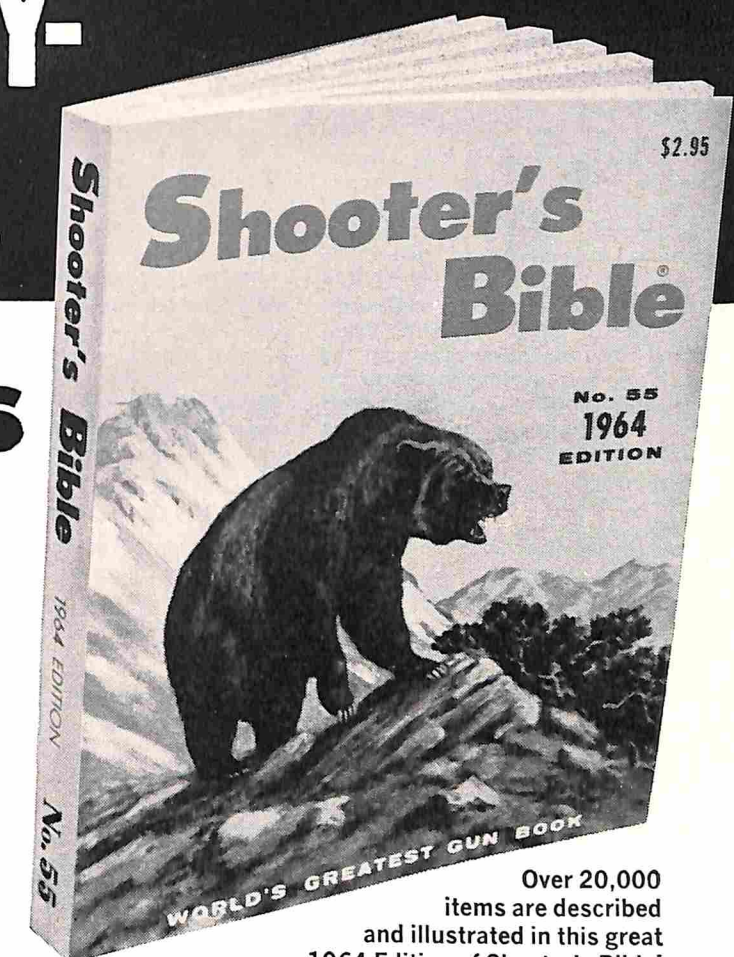
