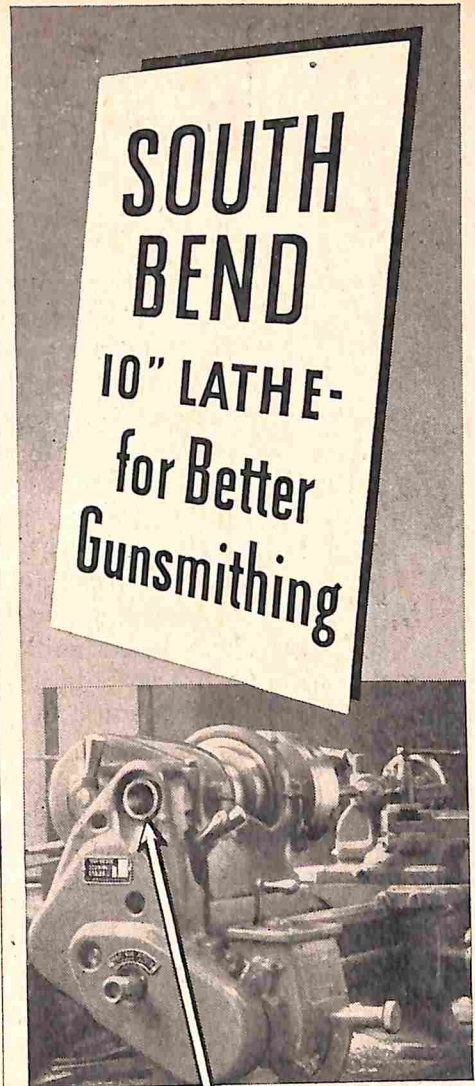

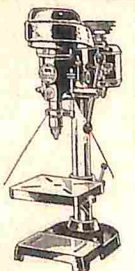


Large, 1-3/8" spindle bore permits chucking gun barrels and other large jobs.
