## Turkey San Francisco starts with Rice-A-Roni's Wild Rice Mix

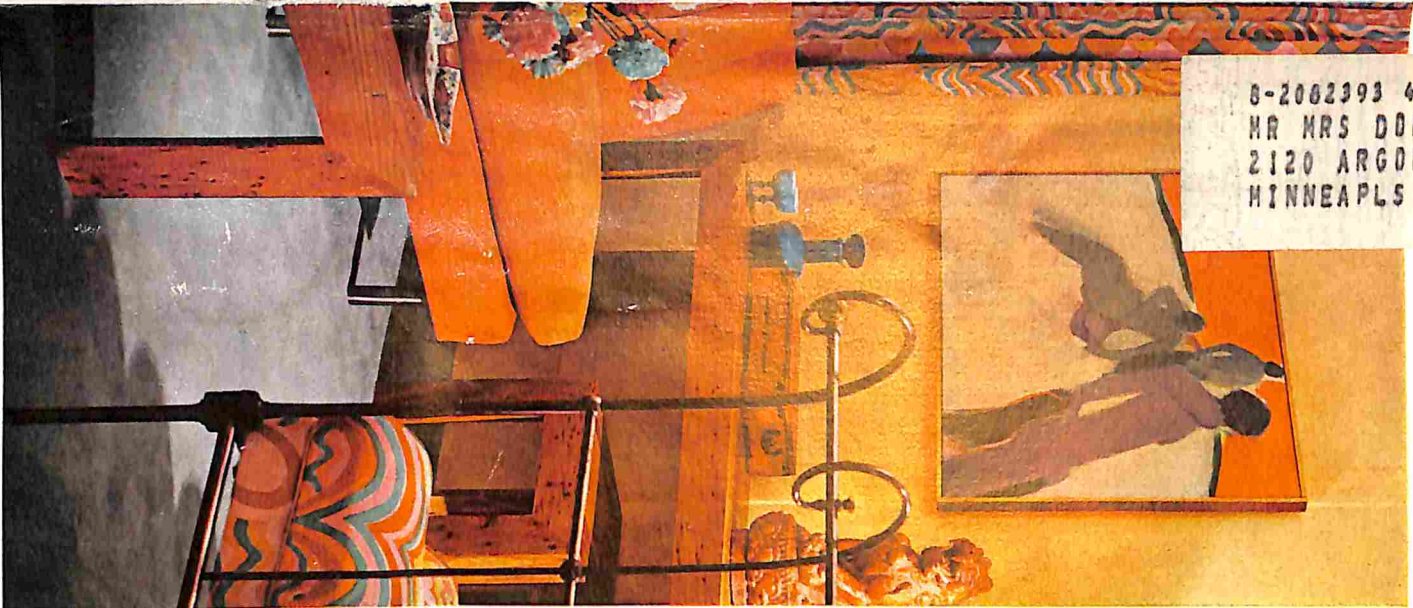
In skillet, brown rice-macaroni mixture in 2 tablespoons butter, stirring frequently. Add 2½ cups hot water and ½ cup diced celery. Stir in contents of wild rice and sauce envelope. Cover pan and simmer until liquid is absorbed and rice is tender, about 30 minutes. Place bird on platter and ring with Wild Rice-A-Roni. Serves 4 to 6.

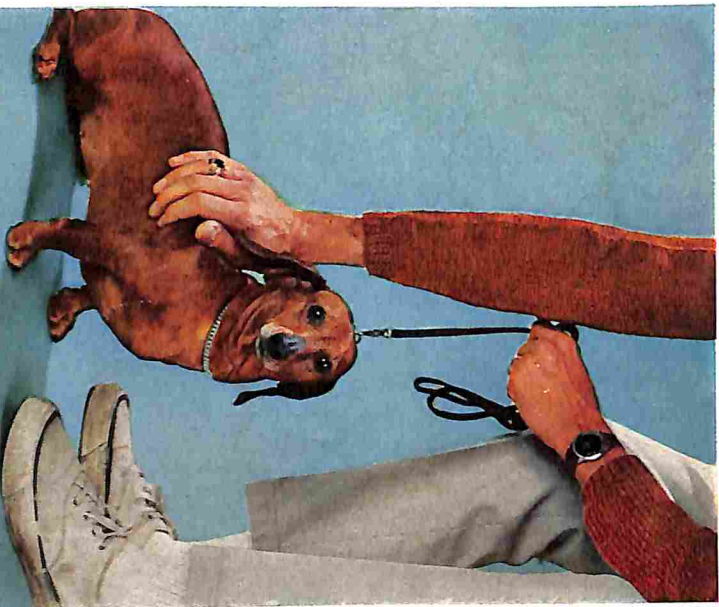
