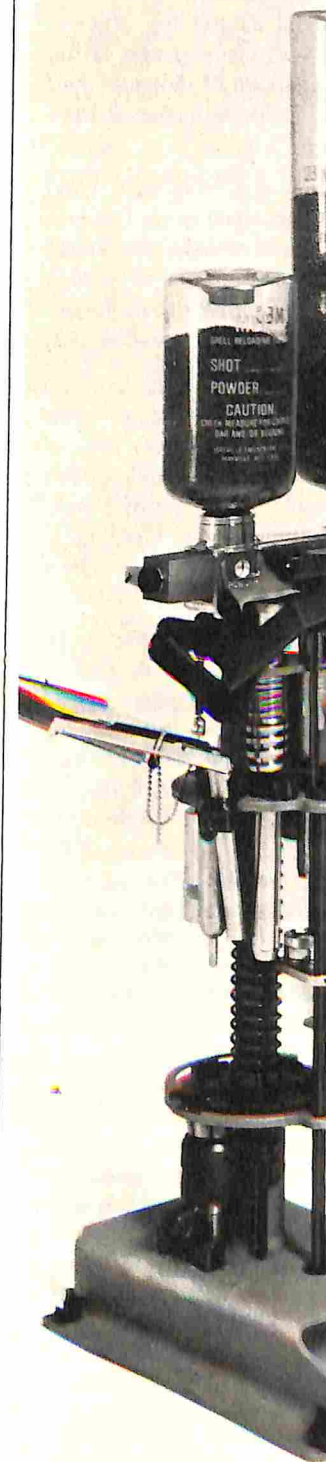

YOUR JULY-AUGUST COVER

The Lee aluminum mould on this month's cover is the No. 429-214SWC casting a .44 caliber semi-wadcutter hollow point. The hollow point pin is integral with the mould. When the handles are opened, the pin automatically centers between the two block halves, then when the handles are closed the pin is perfectly aligned for another cast. We found that casting hollow point bullets with this mould was as fast and easy as Jamison.
