### LIFE'S PICTURES

Dmitri Kessel's picture story on Middle East Oil (pp. 25-37), the first complete pictorial treatment of this world-important subject, appears simultaneously with his return from a nine-month tour of duty through Greece, Palestine, Iran, Iraq, Bahrain Island, Egypt and Saudi Arabia. It took Kessel eight weeks and 26 airplane trips to photograph the widely scattered Middle East oil fields. It was so hot that for periods Kessel could not handle his cameras without scorching his hands.
