## LIFE'S PICTURES

The sequence of pictures showing a rocket-assisted take-off (p. 80-81) were taken by former LIFE Photographer Horace Bristol, now a lieutenant in the U.S. Navy. The camera which recorded the pictures is a new Navy device developed by Bristol and Lieut. Duncan MacPherson. It makes fifty 4x5-in. pictures in 22 seconds at regulated speed. Known as the K-221/2, the camera is being used by the Navy to get picture series of new inventions in action.




