Here he has become one of the country's leading industrial photographers using color extensively to make machines dramatic and beautiful.

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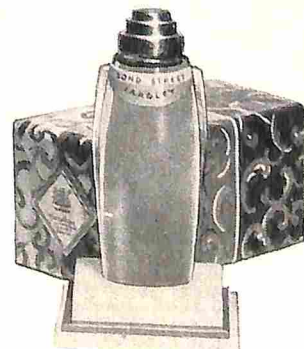
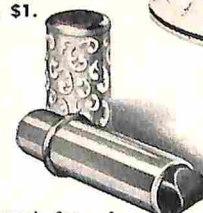
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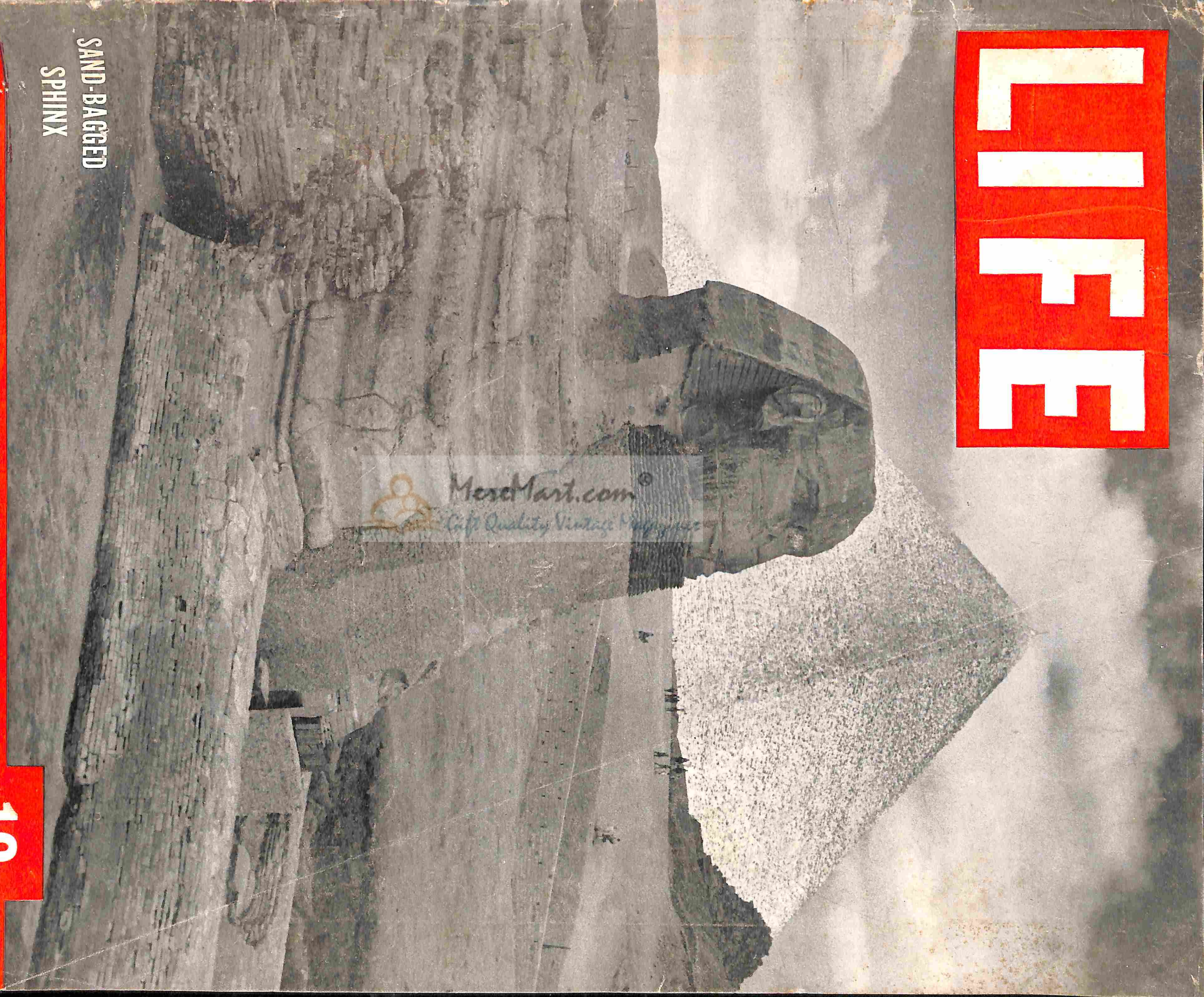
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
