Radiograph of 45 ACP shows bullet hitting metal sheet between two boards, also shows that action opens and case ejects long after bullet has left barrel. Stop motion studies of this nature taken during 2-16 nano-second exposures are of importance in study of arms, ammunition, and gun performance. Field Emission Corp., McMinnville, Ore., pioneered in this type of work and our cover shot is a part of the 45 ACP functioning study performed by Field Emission Corp.

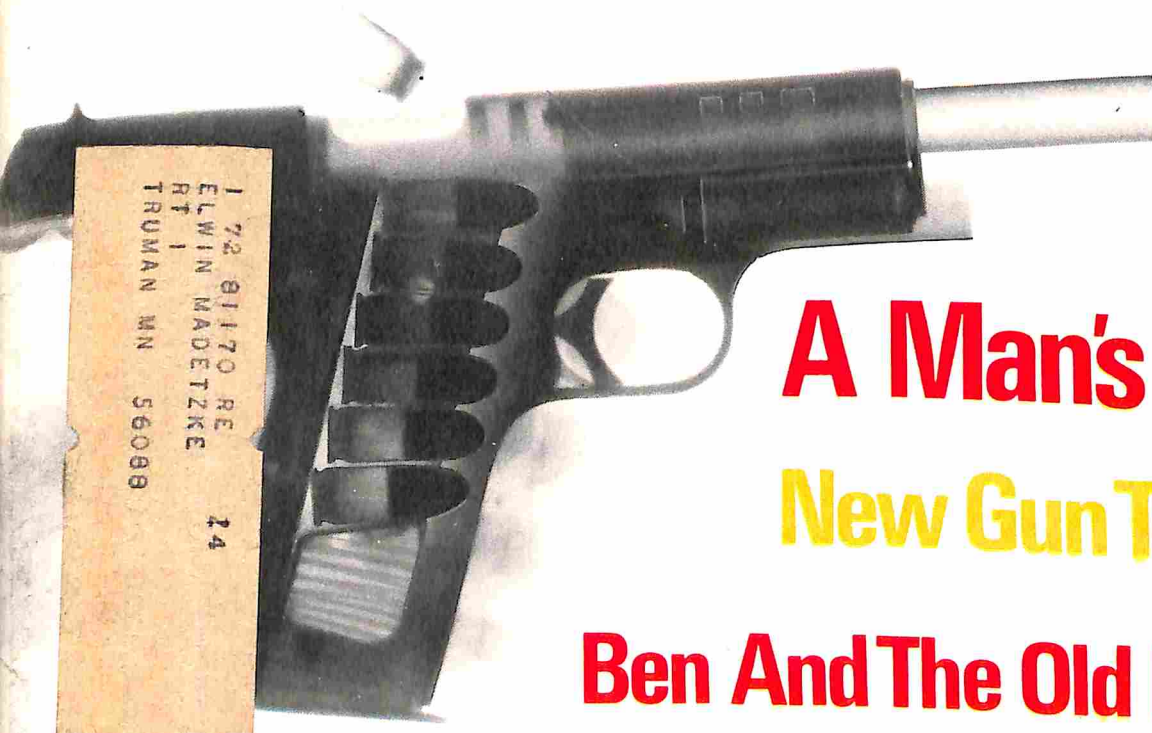
