




We're giving you the recipe.

TREASURE CHESS TARTS

Rich, crunchy, raisin-walnut tarts. Plump 1 cup DEL MONTE Seedless Raisins. Cream together 1 cup sugar and $\frac{1}{4}$ cup margarine or butter; stir in 3 beaten eggs. Add raisins, 1 cup chopped walnuts and 1 tsp. vanilla. Prepare 1 pkg. (9-10 oz.) pie crust mix as package directs. Roll out $\frac{1}{2}$ at a time. Place flattened paper baking cup on dough to cut 12 circles ($4\frac{1}{2}$ in.). Fit paper baking cups and dough into 3-in. muffin tins. Fill each with $\frac{1}{4}$ cup raisin mixture. Bake at 350°F , 40-45 min. Cool; remove paper cups. Top with raisins, candied cherries. Makes 12 tarts.
