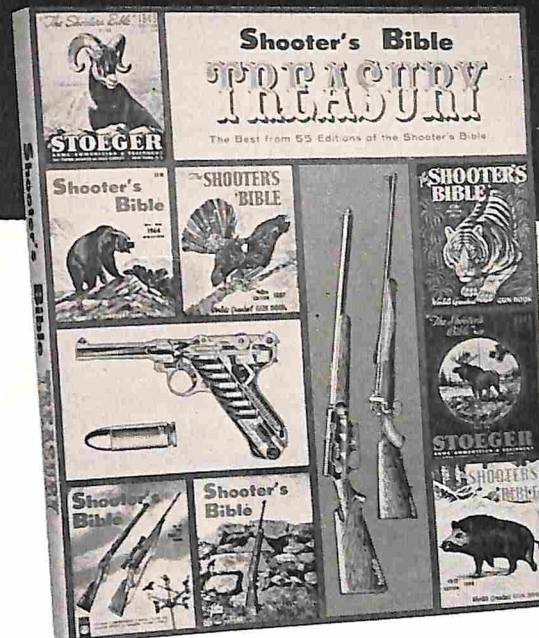
## THE COVER

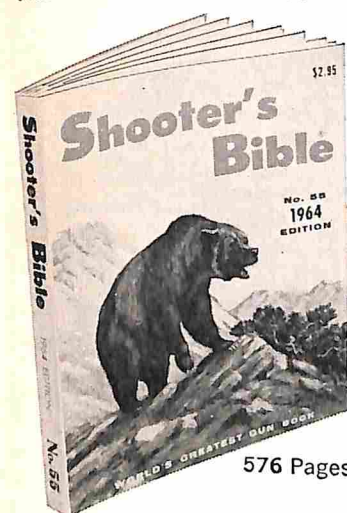
