 The 6%" blade is heat-treated high carbon steel, polished to a mirror finish and deeply acid etched with a ribute inscription and a jungle scene, designed by Viet-nam combat veteran B.J. Weber, with a dragon and ser-pent, symbolic of warfare in Southeast Asia. The blade s hard flash chromed to assure lasting beauty and goldgilt and black enamel infilled for contrast.

The grips are specially made of highly polished black phenolic, checkered to the authentic G.I. pattern, and inset with a full color cloisonne medallion of the service branch insignia.

• 24-karat gold is thickly plated on the crossguard, two releases, butt, two grip screws and two grip nuts — after they are polished to a mirror finish. After the craftsman carefully files, fits and peens together

the 16 components that make up this Bayonet, he inspects it in all particulars and tests it for fit on the M16. Then the individual limited edition serial number is engraved on the blade reverse.
