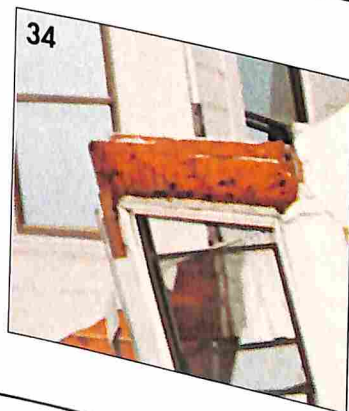
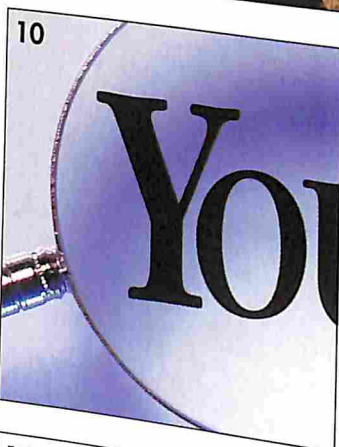

Why We Are


