The paintings of the artist-inventor, Sam-uel F. B. Morse, reproduced on pages 59-62, were photographed by Fernand Bourges of New York. A pioneer in color photography, Mr. Bourges has taken pic-tures of more than 2,000 paintings, including many of the world's great masterpieces, in the last 30 years. He owns 10 cameras, some of which he designed and built him-self. His biggest job was photographing a painting called Pantheon de la Guerre which was 42 feet high and 402 feet long.

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
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


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
