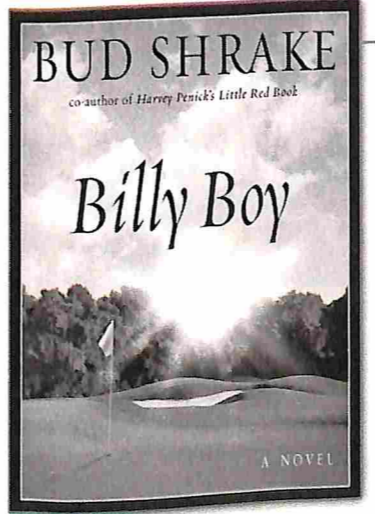
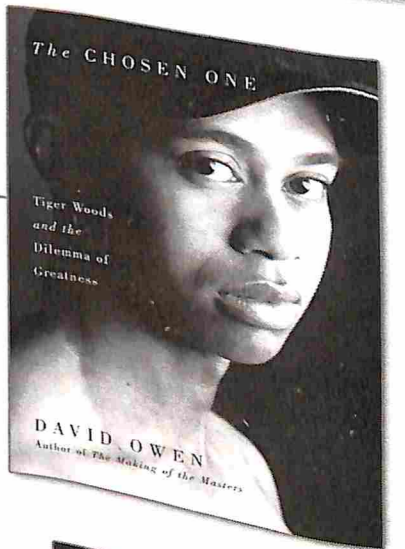
Uncle Boris in the Yukon

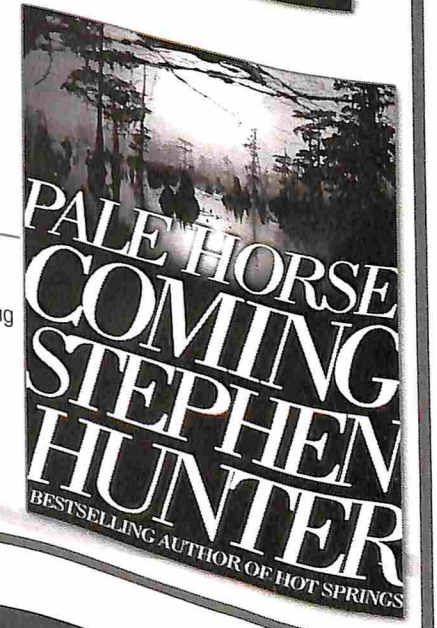

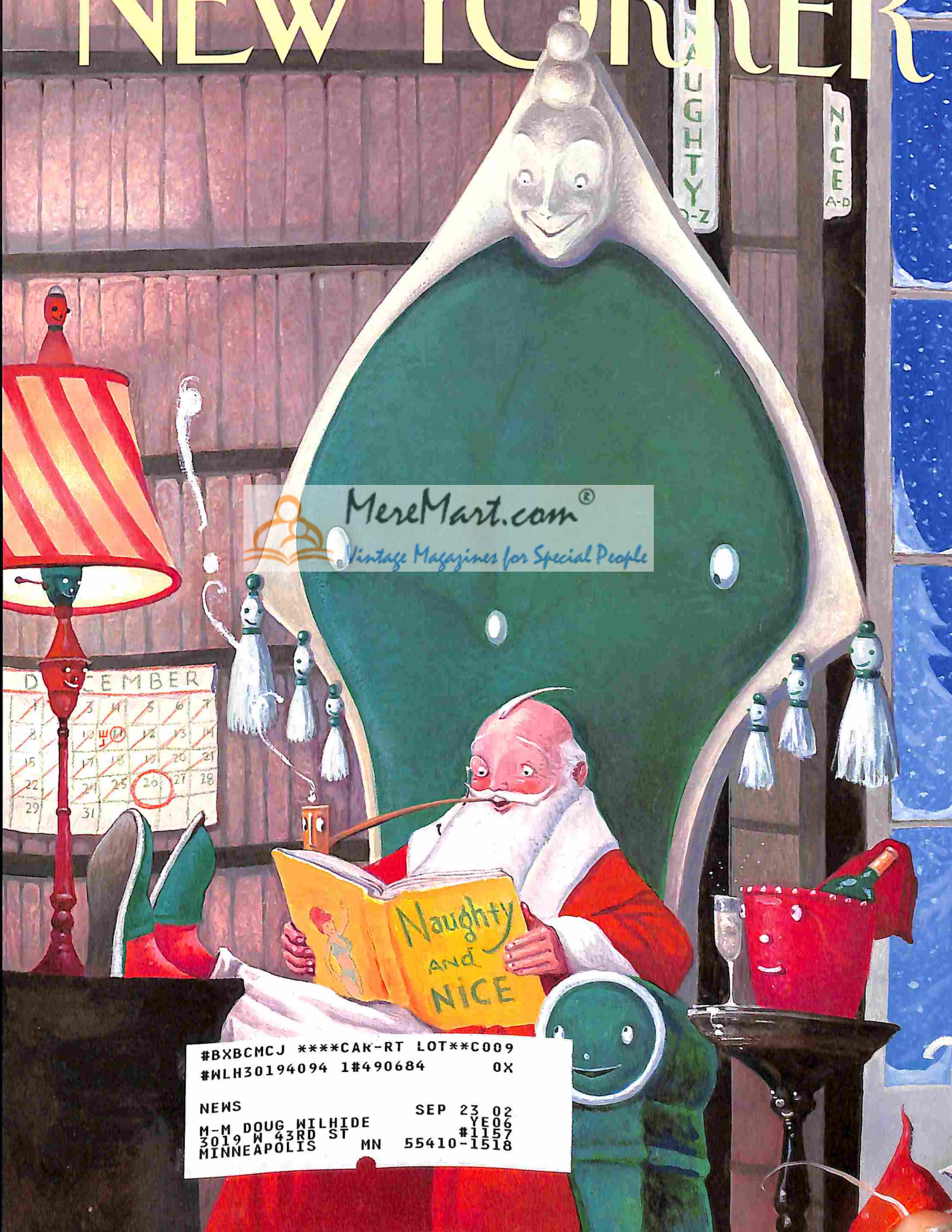
