It is along the Bear River in southern Idaho near the Utah border, in the winter of 1862-63, where a village of Bannock Indians are massacred by Colonel Connor and the 3rd California Infantry. Our last adventure, in Montana, is the attack of a grizzly bear on Frontiersman Hugh Glass. His mangled body is left for dead by his companions. But not so.
