



Eye in the Sky

SITUATION: A range of hills screens enemy activities.
TACTICAL PROBLEM: What is on the other side of the hills?
SOLUTION: Aerial drone surveillance—puts an "eye" in the sky!

Radioplane, in conjunction with the U. S. Army Signal Corps, highly mobile, is producing the SD-1 surveillance drone system. Launched in rough terrain from a camouflaged position and flown by remote control over enemy installations on photo reconnaissance missions—After the target, the SD-1 may be zero-length ground delivery. The camera has exposed its film by radio command. A large man-carrying aircraft. The camera is removed, the film is processed. A surveillance drone system is another example of the art of producing radioplane target support organization for use of drone field activities.

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
